

Vocational Guidance H 2232

BACKGROUND: *The free-floating subdivision –Vocational guidance is used under occupations, fields of endeavor, industries, names of corporate bodies, and individual military services, for works describing careers in these fields or organizations and/or offering advice on how to prepare for, enter, and succeed in these careers. This instruction sheet provides guidelines for assigning this subdivision.*

1. Professions, fields of knowledge, industries, etc. Assign the free-floating subdivision **–Vocational guidance** (*May Subd Geog*) under occupations, fields of endeavor, types of industries, trades, etc., for works on careers in these fields. *Examples:*

```
650 #0 $a Automobiles $x Maintenance and repair $x Vocational
      guidance.
650 #0 $a Bioengineering $x Vocational guidance.
650 #0 $a Dentistry $x Vocational guidance $z United States.
```

The former practice of establishing phrase headings of the type [...] **as a profession** for vocational guidance in professional fields was discontinued in 1975.

2. Classes of persons. Assign the free-floating subdivision **–Vocational guidance** (*May Subd Geog*) under classes of persons or occupational groups only if the heading for the corresponding field or activity does not exist and cannot be established. *Example:*

```
650 #0 $a Allied health personnel $x Vocational guidance.
```

3. Corporate bodies and individual military services. Assign the free-floating subdivision **–Vocational guidance** (*May Subd Geog*) under names of individual corporate bodies and individual military services for works on careers in those organizations or services. *Examples:*

```
610 10 $a United States. $b National Aeronautics and Space
      Administration $x Vocational guidance.
610 10 $a United States. $b Army $x Vocational guidance.
```
