

Relationship between CLW/CCT workshops and PCC training

**What is the relationship between Catalogers Learning Workshop/Cooperative Cataloging Training (CLW/CCT) workshops and Program for Cooperative Cataloging (PCC) training?**

- CCT courses do not fulfill PCC Membership requirements
- The PCC developed CCT workshops jointly with ALCTS
- CCT and PCC courses employ accepted standards and skills
- CCT workshop materials are available to all libraries; PCC trains its members using official PCC program materials presented by an official PCC Program trainer
- PCC members must undergo record review after PCC training
- PCC members contribute program records to shared databases

**CCT workshop sponsors must clarify the distinction between CCT workshops and PCC NACO training when promoting events.**

Basic Creation of Name and Title Authorities

- Recommended as an introduction to name authority work
- Not a substitute for official PCC NACO Membership training
- Includes a module on PCC NACO

Basic Subject Cataloging Using LCSH

- Recommended as an introduction to the principles of LCSH
- Includes a module on PCC SACO

Fundamentals of Library of Congress Classification

- Recommended as an introduction to the principles of Library of Congress Classification
- Includes a module on PCC SACO

Fundamentals of Series Authorities

Recommended as an introduction to series authority work
