Ford Prioleau, George Alfred Trenholm, Theodore D. Wagner, James T. Welsman, and Jacob Williman; together with letters from Major Caleb Huse, European purchasing agent for the Confederate Army and General Colin John McRae, Confederate treasury agent.

Topics include secession, blockade running, supplying the Confederacy, possible payment of Confederate government debts, and the situation in South Carolina during and after the Civil War.
