Biographical data: U.S. Army officer, originally of Canada, serving with 14th Rhode Island Heavy Artillery Regiment (Colored) which was redesignated the 8th U.S. Colored Heavy Artillery Regiment in April 1864, reorganized as 11th U.S. Colored Heavy Artillery Regiment in May 1864, and mustered out at Camp Parapet (New Orleans), La., in 1865.

Summary: Personal and official correspondence, general and special orders, rosters, courts-martial records, and other documents, detailing Cameron's activities during the war, life in the Union Army, and treatment of black troops by white officers.
