Title: Ferdinand Van Derveer correspondence.

Biographical Note: Lawyer, of Middletown, Ohio; fought in the Mexican War; organized the 35th Ohio Volunteer Infantry Regiment and became its first colonel; 1864, appointed Brigadier General of Volunteers and assigned to the IV Corps in Alabama in Jan. 1865; after the war returned to Butler County, Ohio, and served as judge.

Summary: Chiefly Civil War correspondence of Ferdinand Van Derveer, to his wife Emily and family in Hamilton, Ohio.
